



'Mixed-methods evaluation of an enhanced asthma biologics clinical pathway in the West Midlands UK' has been published in the Nature Journal. Co-authored by the Institute of Applied Health Research - University of Birmingham, Royal Stoke University Hospital -University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust and Chris Clowes from Health Innovation West Midlands.

The report shows how a mixed-methods evaluation of an enhanced severe asthma pathway, implemented in Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent, where there is a higher than average prevalence of severe asthma, can improve patient referrals, treatment waiting times and clinical outcomes.
